

2.4 ENNDA Machinery Unit

The Authority has a state of art moving machineries and equipment for hire in the region and outside the region. These are a borehole drilling equipment capable of drilling equipping and test pumping up to 450m and earth moving machines consisting of dozers, excavators, rollers, water boozers, petro tankers, farm tractors, concrete mixers, low loaders and prime movers among others.

3.0 PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES IN LAIKIPIA COUNTY

3.1 Water Points Development

In its endeavour to address the water scarcity in the region for both domestic and livestock and to also provide clean and safe drinking water the Authority has constructed or rehabilitated several water points in the basin. In Laikipia County these include:-

3.2 Participatory Catchment Conservation

i. Establishment of Fuel Wood Plantation

The Authority has also implemented participatory catchment conservation in order to protect the catchment of the Ewaso Ng'iro North River Basin by reducing pressure on the forest for fuel wood and poles through establishment of community woodlots and rehabilitation of degraded forest areas. These activities include establishment of a 60,000 seedlings nursery along Nanyuki River, Distribution of 30,000 indigenous tree seedlings to various groups in Laikipia County.

ii. Promotion of Non Wood Extractive Activities

In order to promote income generation for the local communities without destruction of forests the Authority undertook to promote beekeeping in the entire basin. This entailed training and supply of beehives to several identified groups. In Laikipia the Authority supported 6 groups with 20 beehives each.

3.3 Capacity Building

The Authority has also undertaken several for Water Resources Users Associations, trainings on water management, beekeeping, Gums and Resins, Agro forestry and participatory forest management among others.
