

2.4 ENNDA Machinery Unit

The Authority has a state of art moving machineries and equipment for hire in the region and outside the region. These are a borehole drilling equipment capable of drilling equipping and test pumping up to 450m and earth moving machines consisting of dozers, excavators, rollers, water boozers, petro tankers, farm tractors, concrete mixers, low loaders and prime movers among others.

3.1 Water Points Development

In its endeavour to address the water scarcity in the region for both domestic and livestock and to also provide clean and safe drinking water the Authority has constructed or rehabilitated several water points in the basin. In Mandera County these include:-

3.2 Participatory Catchment Conservation

i. Establishment of Fuel Wood Plantation

The Authority has also implemented participatory catchment conservation in order to protect the catchment of the Ewaso Ng'iro North River Basin by reducing pressure on the forest for fuel wood and poles through establishment of community woodlots and rehabilitation of degraded forest areas. This entailed the distribution of 5,000 Indigenous and 50,000 Exotic Tree Seedlings to groups and institutions in Mandera County.

ii. Promotion of Non Wood Extractive Activities

In order to promote income generation for the local communities without destruction of forests the Authority undertook to promote beekeeping in the entire basin. This entailed training and supply of beehives to several identified groups. The Authority has distributed 120 Langsoth beehives to several beekeeping groups in Mandera County.

The Authority has set up a gums and resins processing plant in Wajir to add value to these abundant resources.

3.3 Capacity Building

The Authority has also undertaken several for Water Resources Users Associations, trainings on water management, beekeeping, gums and resins production, Agro forestry and participatory forest management among others.
